# Program-Specific Examination Regulations for the Master's program in Land Use Transformation

Adopted by the Faculty Council of the Faculty of Agricultural Sciences and Landscape Architecture on April 9, 2024, approved by the University Steering Committee on May 28, 2025, published on June 2, 2025, with effect from March 1, 2026

### § 1 Duration and Structure of Study

<sup>1</sup>The standard period of study, including all exams, is 4 semesters. <sup>2</sup>The study program consists of 120 credit points. <sup>3</sup>Each credit point (ECTS) corresponds to a student workload of 30 hours.

#### § 2 Academic Degree

Osnabrück University of Applied Sciences awards the academic degree "Master of Science (M. Sc.)" to students who have passed the exam.

## § 3 Language

<sup>1</sup>Courses are held in English. <sup>2</sup>Module exams are generally to be taken in the language of instruction.

#### § 4 Final Thesis (Master Thesis)

Admission to the final thesis requires passing the examinations of the first two subject semesters. <sup>2</sup>Admission to the final thesis must be requested from the Office of the University Registrar.

#### § 5 Overall Result

The overall grade for the Master's exam will be determined based on the average of the module grades, weighted according to the number of credit points assigned to each module.

### § 6 Entry into Force

These regulations shall enter into force after their publication in the Official Gazette of Osnabrück University of Applied Sciences, with effect from the summer semester 2026.
