

Selection Process Regulations for the Bachelor's program in Physiotherapy

Adopted by the Faculty Council of the Faculty of Business Management and Social Sciences on November 6, 2024, approved by the University Steering Committee on November 13, 2024, published on January 24, 2025 with effect from March 1, 2025

Section 1 Selection Process

¹In the university's selection process, 90 out of 100 places are awarded after deducting priority quotas; the remaining places are allocated on the basis of waiting times. ²This selection is 100% based on the candidate's special aptitude for the Bachelor's program in combination with the average grade of the university entrance qualification.

Section 2 Participation in the Process

The selection process is only open to candidates who

- a) have applied for a place in the correct form and within the period prescribed, and
- b) do not participate in the allocation procedure as part of a quota to be deducted beforehand in accordance with the Lower Saxony Higher Education Allocation Ordinance (*Hochschulvergabever-ordnung* HVVO), or
- c) have not been allocated a place on the basis of their waiting time.

Section 3 Criteria for Special Aptitude

- (1) Special aptitude for the chosen degree program is determined on the basis of relevant employment. Special aptitude improves the average grade of the candidate's university entrance qualification in accordance with paragraph 2 of these Regulations.
- (2) The average grade of the candidate's university entrance qualification certificate is improved by
 - 0.3 for relevant qualified employment of at least one year following the completion of vocational training.
 - 0.5 for relevant qualified employment of at least five years following the completion of vocational training.
 - 0.8 for relevant qualified employment of at least seven years following the completion of vocational training.

Section 4 Entry into Force

¹These regulations shall enter into force on the day after their publication in the Official Gazette of Osnabrück University of Applied Sciences with effect from the beginning of the application period for the summer semester 2025.
