### **3. Scope and purpose of the data processing**

### **4. Legal basis for the processing of personal data**

The legal basis for the processing of your personal data referred to in the overleaf by the Osnabrück University of Applied Sciences is your consent, Art. 6 (1) sentence 1 lit. a GDPR. The publication of selected image files in (print) publications of the university as well as on their Internet or social media appearances is necessary for the performance of a task in the public interest, Art. 6 (1) sentence 1 lit. e GDPR.

### **5. Duration of the storage of personal data**

Your personal data mentioned above will be stored for as long as needed for the purposes mentioned above. If you revoke your consent, the data will be deleted as soon as possible.

### **6. Your rights as a data subject**

You have a right to information about your personal data processed by the university (Art. 15 GDPR), a right to correct your personal data (Art. 16 GDPR), a right to deletion (Art. 17 GDPR), a right to the limit the processing (Art. 18 GDPR) and a right to the revocation of your consent (Art. 7 (3) GDPR). You also have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority (Art. 78 GDPR).
