

German Language Skills as an admission requirement at Hochschule Osnabrück

Proficiency in German enables the students to follow the lectures and work independently. Therefore, it is an admission requirement.

These are the certificates which are accepted by Hochschule Osnabrück as proof of the applicant's language skills:

- TestDaF: TDN 4 or TDN 5 (minimum of 4 point in each of the 4 parts)
- Deutsche Sprachprüfung für den Hochschulzugang: DSH 2 or DSH 3
- Goethe Zertifikat C1
- Telc C1
- Prüfungsteil "Deutsch" der Feststellungsprüfung des Studienkollegs
- Deutsches Sprachdiplom der KMK Stufe II (DSD II)
- Zentrale Oberstufenprüfung (ZOP) des Goethe-Instituts
- Großes oder Kleines Deutsches Sprachdiplom des Goethe-Instituts (GDS oder KDS)
- Graduates of German language and literature studies

Exceptions

- for the Master programme 'International Business and Management' (taught in English):

- for scholarship holders of the DAAD or other German scholarship awarding institutions: Goethe Zertifikat B1 or other certificates on that level have to be submitted at the time of application. Until the end of the 2nd semester at Hochschule Osnabrück, one of the above mentioned certificates have to be acquired.
