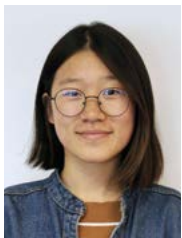
## QUALITY ENGINEERING made in Germany

<b>Location</b>	Osnabrück UAS Faculty of Engineering and Computer Science Albrechtstraße 30 D-49076 Osnabrück, Germany
<b>Date</b>	Starting regularly on 1 March for one semester (until July)
<b>Prerequisite</b>	At least 180 ECTS (3 academic years) in any engineering field
<b>Semester Fees</b>	Reduced semester fees for visiting students from partner universities
<b>Language</b>	English
<b>Application Deadline</b>	1 November of previous year
