# CHARACTERISTICS OF THE STUDY PROGRAM

The dual training-integrating bachelor's degree program in nursing, B.Sc., is carried out in cooperation between Osnabrück University of Applied Sciences and the three cooperating vocational schools Akademie St. Franziskus GmbH in Lingen, Bildungs-Institut Gesundheit am Klinikum in Leer and the Schulungszentrum am Ludmillenstift in Meppen. Three other cooperating vocational schools are part of the network-leading vocational school in Meppen: the Bildungsstätte für Gesundheitsberufe of the Euregio-Klinik in Nordhorn, the DENKWERK - Zentrum für Bildung im Gesundheitswesen of Evangelischer Krankenhausverein Emlichheim e.V. and the School for elderly care of the Marienhausschule in Meppen. The transfer between theory and practice is the focus of the nursing program through project and casestudies, using work-based learning, which is accompanied by the university of applied science.

The program combines generalist nursing training with a bachelor's degree. During the four years, students learn in blocks at three learning locations: university of applied science, vocational school and a clinic/ care facility. After four years, two degrees are achieved: the Bachelor of Science in Nursing and the state professional nursing qualification. During there studies the students get a training refunding from their care facility.
