<p>Mandatory health insurance > must be valid during the whole period of the stay in Germany</p>	<p><u>EU students:</u> European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) <u>Non-EU students:</u> German public health insurance to be concluded in Osnabrück in the first week after arrival. <i>Foreign or private insurances will not be accepted!</i></p> <p>In addition, we recommend to effect an accident and a private liability insurance, plus a travel health insurance for the journey to Germany.
