From Monday onwards, there will be no more tests available for free in the testing centers throughout the country. Therefore, we'll address this in today's newsletter:

Possibilities to Self-Test at the University

Starting on Monday, October 11th 2021, the university will offer the possibility to self-test to all those students who have not yet been (fully) vaccinated or who have not yet fully recovered from a COVID-19 infection. Every Faculty will open a test station.

If your **result is negative**, you will receive a written confirmation that is valid for 24 hours and will give you access to each university building in order to participate in your classes. If your **result is positive**, you may not enter any university building. Instead, you will have to self-isolate yourself immediately and make an appointment for a PCR-test. The university is obligated to indicate all positive test results to the health authorities.

Testing-Stations in the Faculties

The following testing stations are available to students on the different campuses:

Faculty of Agriculture and Landscape Architecture (Haste Campus) Building HF, Cafeteria in the Student Center Monday through Friday, 07:30 a.m. until 09:30 a.m.

Faculty of Engineering and Computer Science (Westerberg Campus) Building AA (entrance from the parking lot) in the Dean's Office area. Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. until 10 a.m.

Faculty of Management, Culture, and Technology (Lingen Campus) Hall I/II South Entrance (from the parking lot) Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. until 10 a.m.

Faculty of Business Management and Social Sciences (Caprivi Campus) Building CK, Foyer Caprivi-Lounge (CaLo) Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. until 10 a.m.

Institute of Music

Students of the Institute of Music are welcome to use the testing stations on Westerberg and Caprivi Campuses).

Important: Please bring your CampusCard, a personal ID (or passport) and an accredited **corona antigen self-test** with you. In addition, please bring your own pen and the following form: <u>"Bescheinigung Selbsttest Studierende"</u> which can be found on the university's corona website. In order to speed up the process, please fill out the form in advance.

Should you forget your self-test at home, the Student Council (AStA) offers self-tests for sale during the usual opening hours.

International degree-seeking and exchange students whose vaccinations are not accredited in Europe and who have not had the chance to receive an accredited vaccination yet, can

obtain self-tests for free from the university. Please ask for a free test when you enter the testing area on your campus.
