The focus of the professorship should be on the social science dimensions of sustainable social transformation. Therefore, the professorship particularly aims to enable students to help shape the transformation of our society. In the spirit of "We for Tomorrow," the professorship provides the necessary subject matter and didactic expertise to allow students to engage with national and international societal issues during their studies and to make the transformation of the global society tangible.

We expect the holder of the professorship to provide impulses and international perspectives regarding the further development of our degree programs. In addition to teaching social science, and in particular sociological, foundations and the professorship's activities in research, the focus is particularly set on the topic of "sustainable social transformation." In the context of the social science engagement with sustainability, it is about social and economic contexts, which can then be linked, for example, in cross-faculty collaborations with technical or ecological aspects. Ideally, students experience and shape the engagement with the transformation of society themselves during their studies.

The professorship primarily teaches in the following degree programs: BA Public Management, BA Public Administration, BA Social Work, BA Public Administration (Dual), BA International Economics and Sustainability, MA Social Work, MA Management in Non-Profit Organizations. The teaching will be future-oriented and increasingly conducted in English

For the appointment to a professorship at Osnabrück University of Applied Sciences, the criteria of the NHG (https://www.hs-osnabrueck.de/berufungskriterien) apply. These must be strictly met.

For the advertised professorship, these criteria according to § 25 (1) NHG are specified as follows:

- A completed university degree in the disciplines of social sciences, sociology, or a related discipline is expected.
- Proof of the special ability for in-depth independent scientific work is generally provided through an aboveaverage doctorate. Proof of achievements equivalent to a doctorate may be possible.
- The professional career (5 years of professional practice, at least 3 years outside the university sector) must have demonstrable relevance to the contents and tasks of the professorship. Furthermore, outstanding achievements must result from this activity.
- The development of our students, the imparting of knowledge, and enthusiasm for the special features of the subject are the focus of the future position holder (pedagogical-didactic aptitude). Corresponding teaching experience, preferably with students, must therefore be demonstrated.

Furthermore, the following qualifications are desirable:

- Experience in the development and implementation of innovative and interactive teaching concepts



- Experience in identifying and researching megatrends in the social sciences (e.g., promoting democracy, AI, sustainability, diversity, digitalization, skills shortage) or their design
- International experience and cooperation in teaching, practice, and research
- Experience in inter-/transdisciplinary collaboration
- Cooperative leadership style towards students and staff Gender and diversity competence as well as intercultural competence
- Experience in self-administration/program development
